

PERMIT TO ENROLL IN SCHOOL OF MARINE SCIENCE COURSE NON-DEGREE SEEKING APPLICATION

The School of Marine Science accepts non-degree seeking applications from individuals who have earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Permission to enroll in a graduate marine science course as a non-degree seeking student does not imply admission to any graduate program at the College of William and Mary. Graduate credit earned in a marine science course as a non-degree seeking student may be applied toward a marine science degree if the student is admitted to a degree program.

Instructions:

1. Status is granted for one semester only; a new application must be filed for each term.
2. Complete this form. Return to the VIMS/SMS Graduate Registrar in Watermen's Hall, Room 253 or send form electronically to Registrar@vims.edu.
3. If you were not enrolled last semester at the College of William and Mary and you wish to apply for Virginia in-state tuition eligibility, you must submit the **Application for In-State Tuition Privileges** when you return this application, or by the first day of classes. 4. If your application is approved and processed, you will receive an email to the address provided on your application with instructions on setting up your WM account, to gain access to email, Blackboard, and Banner. Most college communication will be sent to your WM email address. If you have not received any communication within a week of the beginning of the term, please contact the VIMS/SMS Graduate Registrar.
5. If a fee is required, you will be billed by the College of William and Mary. The bill can be viewed by logging into <http://my.wm.edu>; select "Banner;" "Student;" "Student Account;" then "eServices". Current tuition rates are available here: <http://www.wm.edu/offices/financialoperations/sa/tuition/index.php>.

The College of William and Mary is required under federal law to request your taxpayer identification number, which for most enrolling students is a Social Security number. Federal law requires us to provide to the Internal Revenue Service certain information about all enrolled students, including a taxpayer identification number.

Under §23-2.2:1 of the Code of Virginia, and the regulations thereunder, every institution of higher education located in Virginia is required to provide to the State Police certain student data, including name, date of birth and expected date of attendance. When you enroll, William and Mary must comply with this legislation and will do so in a way that safeguards the information provided. The College reserves the right to deny admission to convicted felons or persons not eligible to return to the last institution attended.

Information regarding your ethnicity is voluntary and allows the College to comply with reporting requirements of the State Council for Higher Education in Virginia.
